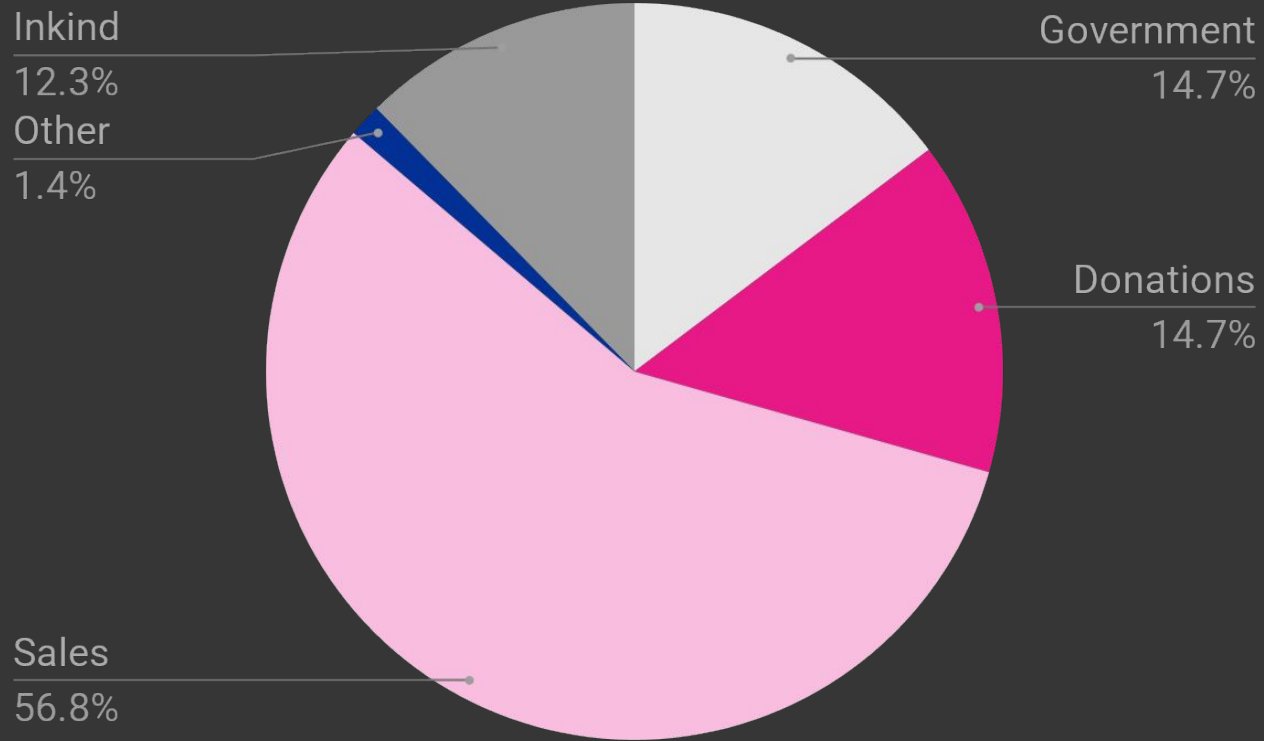
Total Revenue \$1,061,526

Total Expenses \$991,465

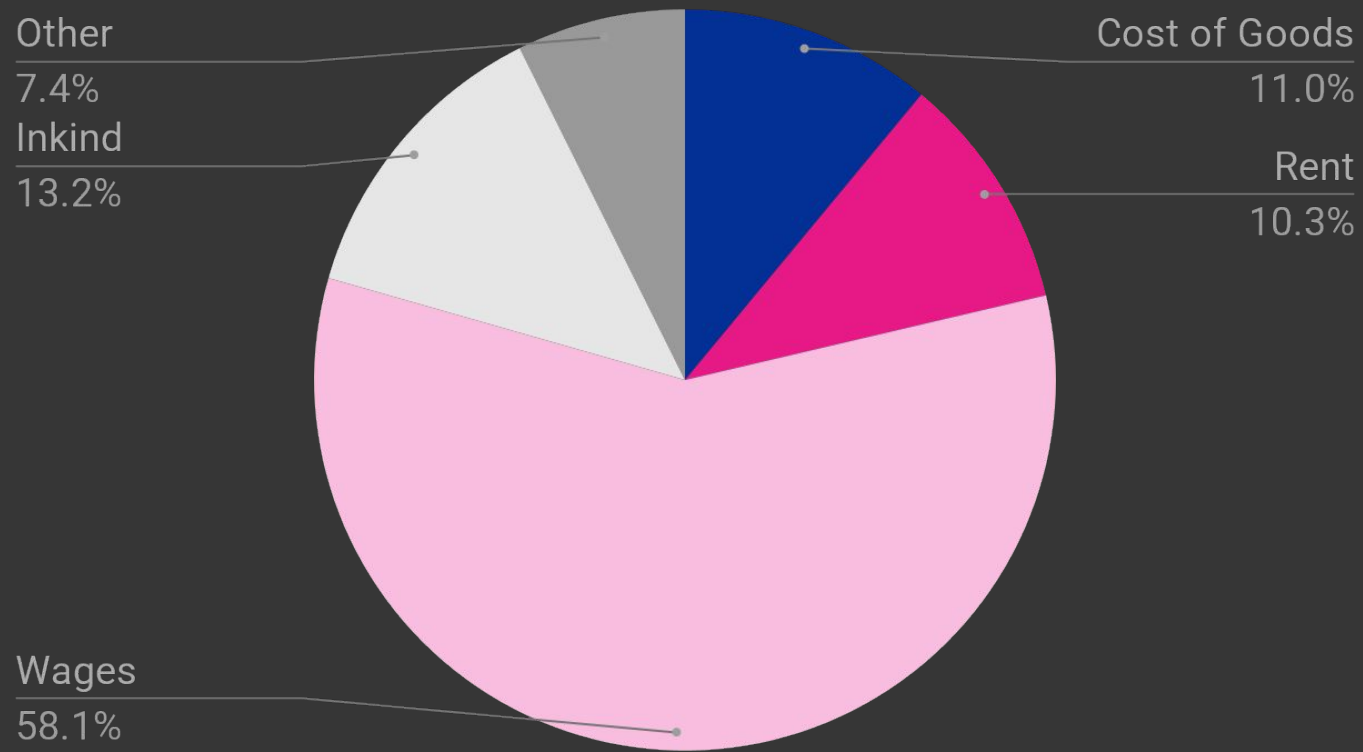
In line with our goal for the year we successfully added \$60,000 to our Contingency Move account to prepare for that eventuality.
